

## ACCESSIBILITY

Tennis Yukon spends considerable time and effort making tennis accessible to the entire community. No one has ever been turned away from a Tennis Yukon program or from accessing the Mt Mac courts; Tennis Yukon has never rejected a request for accommodation on a fee and in fact has made individual arrangements several times.

- Free transportation by volunteers for kids from several schools so they can get to tennis.
- Equipment is provided to all players in all programs at no cost.
- Junior team tennis is a very affordable introductory program with equipment, shirts, and snacks provided.
- Community partnerships: Skookum Jim, Bethany Church, Mt Lorne, Marsh Lake. Girl Guides, ElderActive, all with equipment and a certified instructor.
- Tennis Yukon undertakes several funding applications each year to subsidize programs and keep them affordable. Many of these funding programs, through the City of Whitehorse and Yukon Governments, are aimed at participation by girls, first nations, rural communities, schools, and elderly. Tennis Yukon has targeted all of these areas.
- Tennis Yukon actively maintains the Mt Mac courts, so that they stay the valuable community resource that they are.
