

CODE OF CONDUCT

Tennis Yukon Association is committed to fair play in sport. Players and parents are encouraged to read and follow the fair play codes set forth below. All players, parents, and coaches are required to sign the Code of Conduct at the first lesson of each session.

I promise to:

- be courteous, considerate, and helpful to teammates, coaches, competitors, officials, and the general public;
- demonstrate good sportsmanship and participate/watch according to the rules and in the spirit of fair play;
- adhere to any regulations established during competitions and/or travel. These may include curfews, nutritional guidelines, drug and alcohol prohibitions, and safety rules;
- participate in team activities and encourage team spirit;
- be punctual;
- communicate with coaches about expected absences prior to the absence;
- communicate with coaches about issues arising with either performance or other participants;
- make restitution for any personal or property damage during participation in a Tennis Yukon program or event;
- remain at competitions for award presentations, banquets, and other events unless previous arrangements are approved by the coaches;
- wear team uniforms when requested to do so.

Failure of a player to comply with any of the above commitments will result in the following course of action:

- a. Informal reprimand (verbal);
- b. Phone call/meeting between parent, player, and coach;
- c. Formal reprimand (written);
- d. Temporary suspension from a competition;
- e. Permanent suspension from a competition;
- f. Dismissal from Tennis Yukon, including any team competing in a competition;
- g. If applicable, immediate return home at own cost.

Failure of a parent to comply with any of the above commitments will result in he or she being asked to leave the practice, competition, and/or venue.

Failure of a coach to comply with any of the above commitments will result in a meeting with the Tennis Yukon Board.
